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In PE (on Wednesdays) we will be learning some traditional playground games.

We will be creating lots of props to support our Fairy Tale role play as well as looking at home art can be used to describe a character.

We will be using the characters behaviour to think about how they make others feel. We will use this to look at our own behaviour and its effect on others.

In Maths we will be focusing on building our addition and subtraction skills. We will also be looking at how we can take our problem solving skills into our play to make us master mathematicians! We will also be making link to the books we are reading – measuring our heads for crowns, weighing out ingredients for cakes and using time words in our stories.

We will be using technology to take photos of ourselves, create Fairy Tale maps and to investigate more about the different characters.
