

Remission of Charges for School Journeys

Remission of any charges levied by St Saviour's School will normally be granted where:

a) Parents are in receipt of family credit or income support (and in the case of board and lodging the activity can be classified as taking place in school hours, and if outside school hours is provided specifically to fulfil requirements of the National Curriculum, Religious Education or a specification of a prescribed public examination), to leave to the Head's decision the proportion of an activity which should be charged to public or non-public funds. A scheme of remissions for up to 30% of the school activity should be facilitated for families in receipt of family credit or income support;

or

b) The Head teacher has recommended remission of the charges in individual case of hardship.
