Dear Families,

Phonics starts at 9:05, as soon as the register is completed after Fit in 5. Punctuality is always important, a life skill really, at this time for all the children it can make a difference to their confidence and disruption experienced by the whole class. The gates are open ten minutes early to give people time to come in, settle and be ready at 9:00. Please make sure your child is in and ready to learn.

Thank you to all the children who are parking their scooters and not playing with balls at the start and end of day. Please reinforce the message that this is not what we do because when we have babies in the playground we do not want to risk hurting them or anyone else. We keep play for playtimes.
