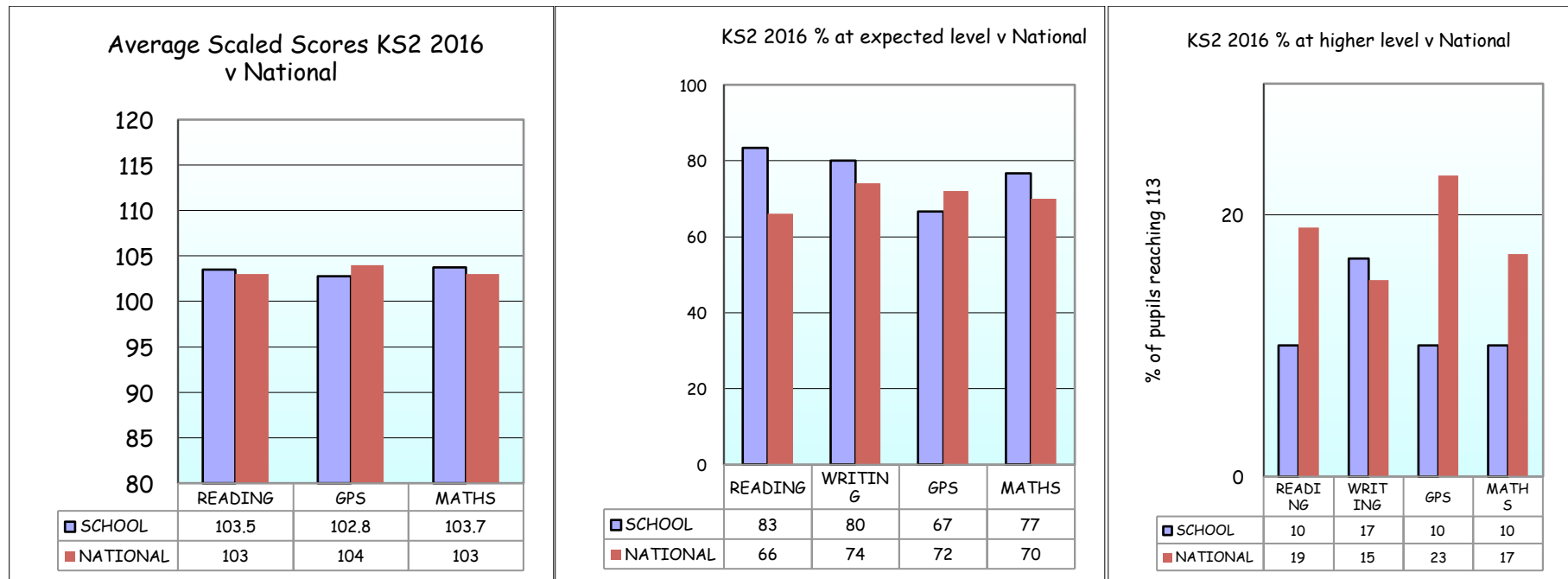


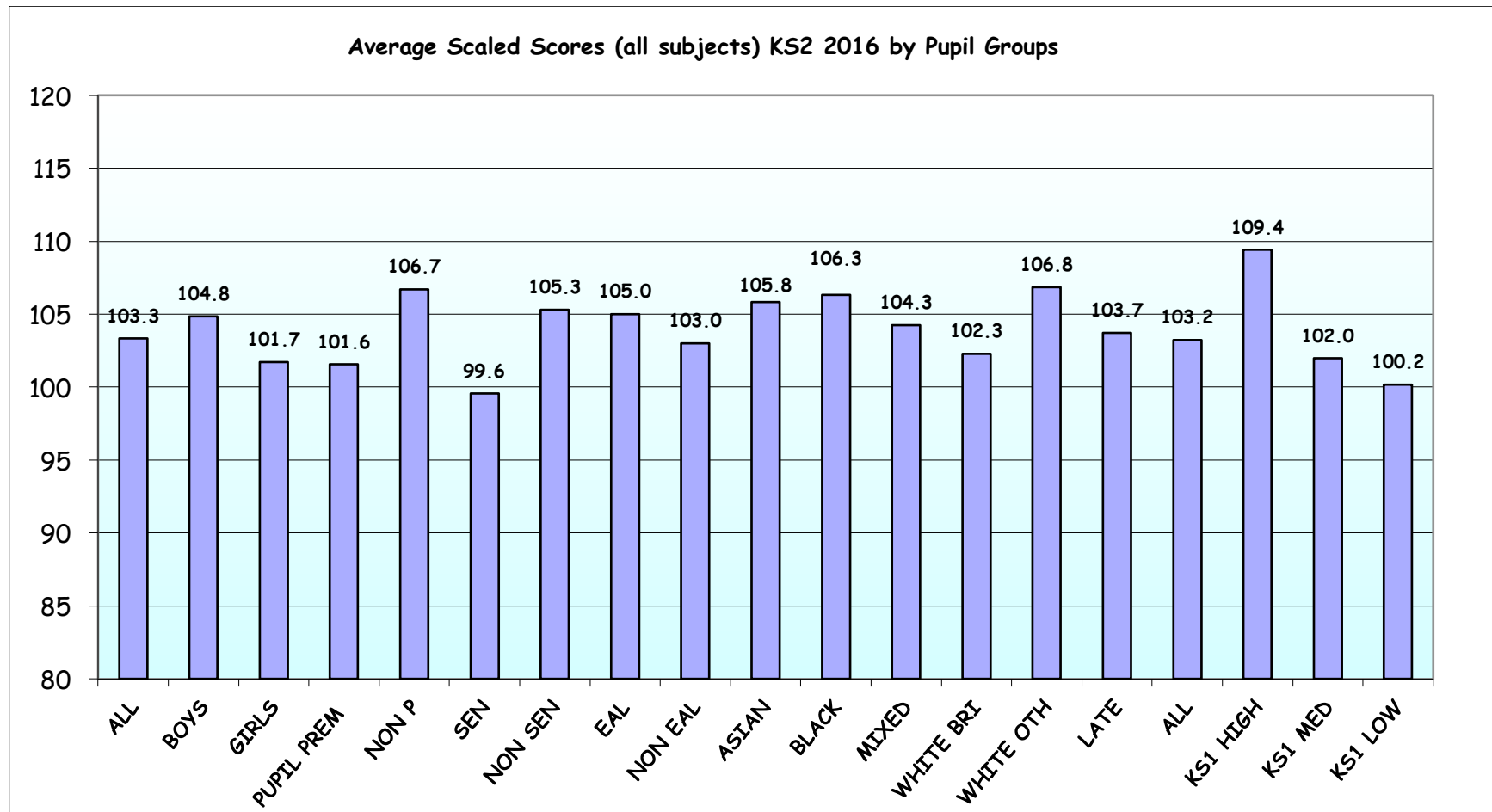
St Saviour's outcomes for pupils 2015 to 2016



We are pleased with how well pupils did on reading and whilst above national in all apart from the Grammar, Punctuation and Spelling test, this was primarily due to spelling errors rather than grammatical knowledge.

We are disappointed with the amount of pupils who were able to reach the higher levels in comparison to national. We believe there were more pupils who were achieving greater depth in terms of skills who did not reach the score of 113 on the test.

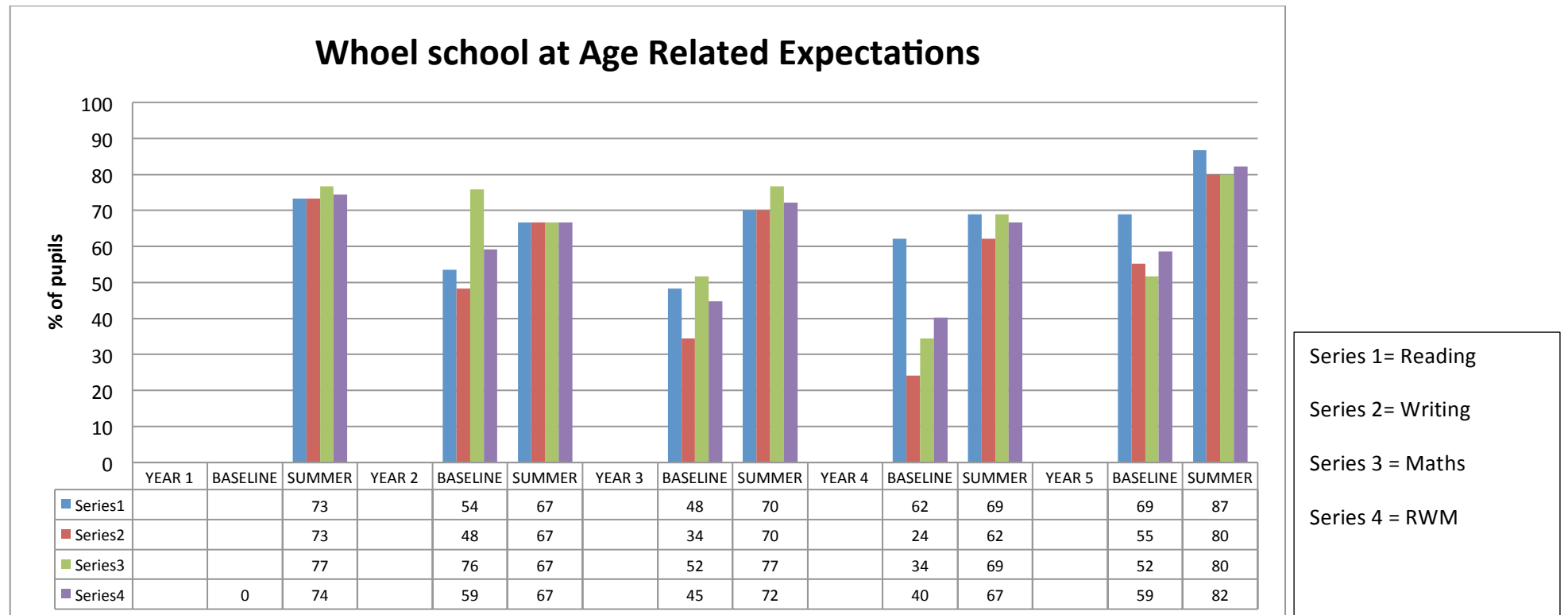
St Saviour's outcomes for pupils 2015 to 2016



Our SEN rises to 100+ without pupils with Educational Health and Care Plans.

The baseline is established by translating the children's previous national curriculum levels into points along a continuum worked along the Tower Hamlets assessment group. They have been adopted into a new tracking system so as to be able to measure progress. The previous assessment points are not matched by the current system so more pupils would be thought of not meeting the new needs of the NC in keeping with higher expectations for all.
